

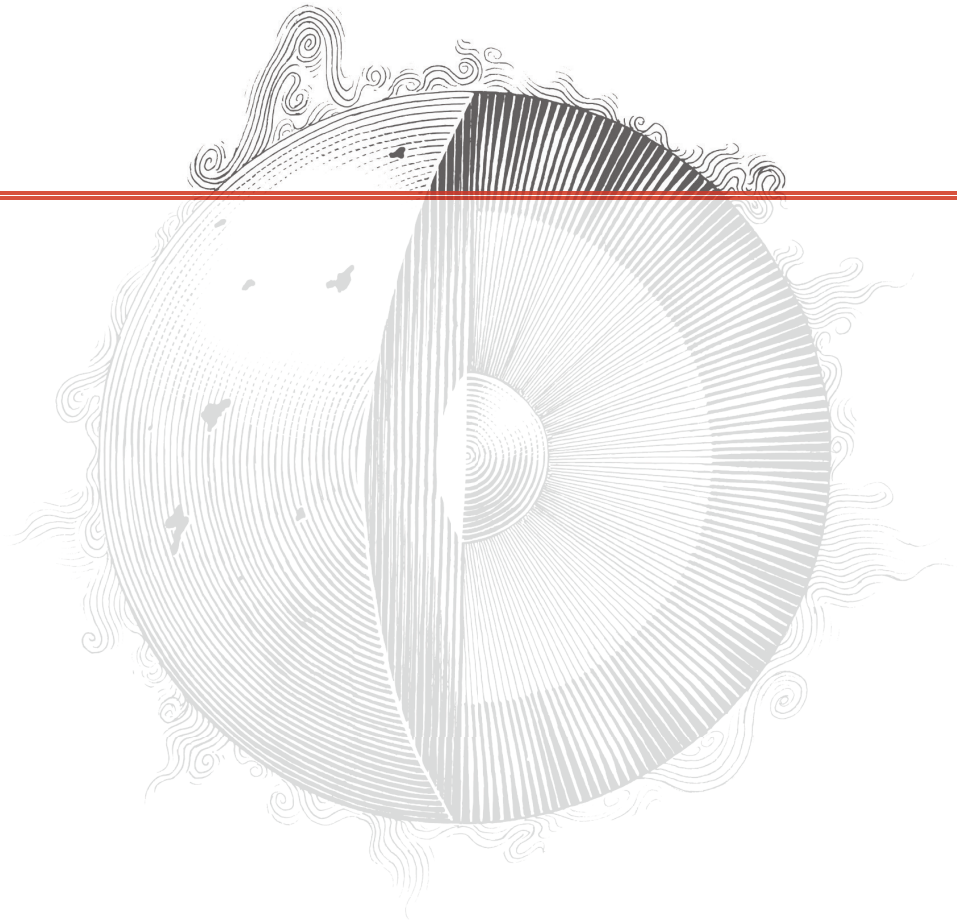
A CRITICAL INSTRUCTIONAL DESIGN OF YOUR OWN
