# 4-credit TIDE courses are open to all students




- ► Four courses for the Certificate; five for the Major
  - 1. BU 2040. Foundations of Innovation and Entrepreneurship : Provides a foundational knowledge of entrepreneurship and innovation, creation of new (ad)ventures
  - 2. BU 2460. Design Thinking and Venture Start-Up: Identify opportunities, use design thinking to build and validate the value proposition (Prerequisite: Marketing)
  - 3. BU 3030. Social Entrepreneurship: Apply entrepreneurial skills to create, organize, and manage a social project.
  - 4. BU 4050. Capstone: Lean Incubation and Business Venture Planning. Build and validate a repeatable and scalable business model based on transformative innovation and value creation.
  - 5. FOR BS GENERAL MANAGEMENT MAJORS ONLY: BU 3111. Entrepreneurial Growth & Strategy: Evaluate the challenge of implementing high growth, innovation, and entrepreneurial strategies


